## **Sabino Cannone mixes songs for MTV Italy's Ultrasounds Competition**

*Sample library author's production tips featured on recent episode*

Chicago, IL USA/Canosa di Puglia, Italy — September 22, 2008 — Sabino Cannone, author of the MoReVoX libraries, was recently contacted by MTV Italy to record and mix two songs which were selected in the Ultrasounds competition.

Ultrasounds, sponsored by Samsung, is multi-faced competition in which several creatives from each step of the music creation process collaborate to make original songs. Out of 9000 lyric entries, seven were chosen to be developed by composer and an arranger/producer. After the songs are finalized, they are recorded and mixed in the studio with musicians and engineers. Cannone was chosen to record and mix "Can't Explain". Cannone used Drumagog on this mix, in conjunction with his Elektromorph sample library.

After the recording process, videos are created for each song, and then placed into heavy rotation on MTV Italy. Cannone's production techniques were featured on a recent 45 minute episode about the competition.

Cannone has developed several sample libraries under the MoReVoX name, including Elektromorph I, Elektromorph II, and Drumbuster. The Elektromorph libraries are recorded with unique top quality signal paths to create individual sound coloring, then edited in detail in both analog and digital domains. Drumbuster, recorded with a Neve VR to 2" Studer A80, is the easiest way to immediately boost your tracks.

Cannone's libraries, tailored in GOG format, are available for purchase from the WaveMachine Labs, Inc. website ([www.drumagog.com](http://www.drumagog.com)). Elektromorph I (DVD \$149, Download \$139), Elektromorph II (DVD \$189, Download \$179), Elektromorph I&II bundle (DVD \$309, Download \$299), and Drumbuster (Download \$39) are Cannone's current libraries, he is also working on a DriveDrums library for future release.
